

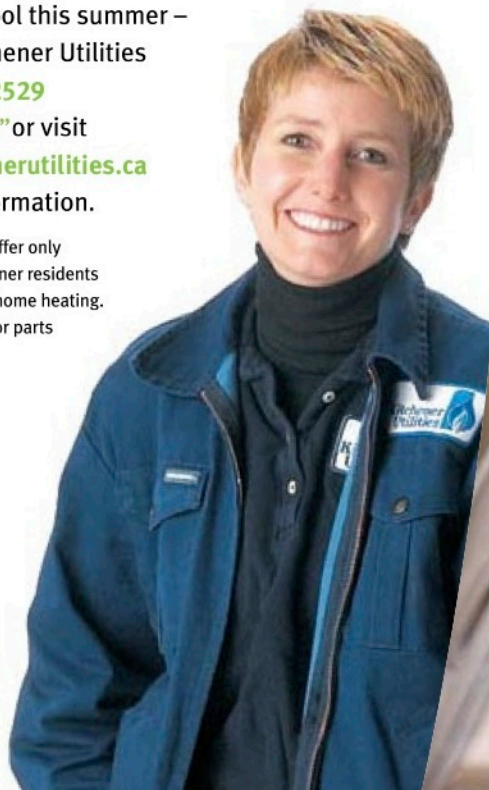
You're ready for summer

Tip: Get rid of the chlorine smell or taste

Chlorine is added to our drinking water to ensure that it is safe for drinking, cooking, and other everyday uses. The amount of chlorine is within the Canadian Drinking Water Guidelines and Ontario Drinking Water Standards. If you notice a slight taste or smell from your tap water, try:

- Storing water in an open glass container in your fridge.
- Washing your reusable pitcher or water bottle regularly.
- Using a water pitcher with a filter that you change regularly.
- Installing a carbon filter on your tap.
